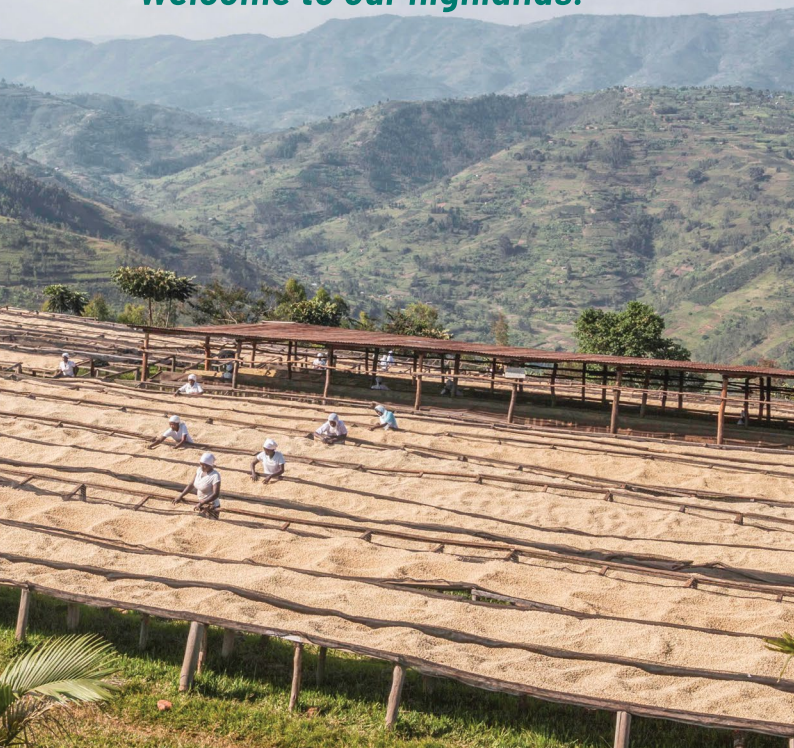

It starts from nursery to farm practices like planting, weeding, mulching, pruning, and harvesting. We offer an exquisite tour of the coffee washing station with a demonstration at each step of processing, dry milling, and experience differences in traditional vs modern roasting practices. For coffee enthusiasts, the hands-on cupping experience at the origin is second to none. The day is crowned with café services, seated on a hill peak at 2,200m elevation while cheering the sun peeps over the horizon.

The day kicks with an uphill walk, trekking Buzinganjwiri hill which provides a relinquishing moment to conquer 3,000m elevation, marvelously witnessing the wonders of nature. On the sidehill, there sits the royal palace of renowned king Mibambwe III Sentabyo lived in between 1741-1746, where monumental trees from the seventeenth century still stand. You will interact with the cultural bounds of kingdom stories and rare archaeological crafts of humankind. From time to time, the monarchy was mobile, moving the court between various locations. At Mbilima & Matovu, you will witness courtyards where kings would render righteous judgment, alike King Salomon of Jews. The nights are graced by Igitaramo "cultural nights" relaxing in front of an open crackling fire, listening to game of thrones stories, prowess well vaunts, and braveries of old centuries while sharing local and local drinks.
